### **SaskCentral board elects new president, welcomes new members**

**Saskatoon, April 15, 2008** -- The board of directors of SaskCentral has elected Don Blocka of Conexus Credit Union as the new board president. Blocka is an agricultural producer from the Prince Albert area. He has served on the SaskCentral board since 2002.
