SaskCentral Sponsors Saskatchewan Flame Exhibition

SaskCentral is proud to sponsor the Saskatchewan Flame Exhibition at the Art Gallery of Regina.

The opening reception for the exhibition will be held on **Wednesday, April 16 from 7:00 – 9:00 pm** at the Art Galley of Regina. Media representatives are invited to attend.

The exhibition presents the works and kilns of the Saskatchewan makers who used wood for firing their wares. For centuries all over the world, wood has been the only available fuel used by potters to transform their clay creations into permanent wares. Only recently, other fuels have been used for that purpose. Modern ceramists have also used wood firing and the melted ashes deposited during that process as an aesthetic choice.

The Saskatchewan Flame Exhibition includes works from Peter Rupchan and Nick Sarota (1920/30), Randy Woosley (1981) and Martin Tagseth (2007). It is a varied and informative display of 36 works made by 25 makers and fired in 10 Saskatchewan kilns.

The exhibition is curated by Charley Farrero with support from the Saskatchewan Arts Board and is circulated by Sask Terra.

The Saskatchewan Flame Exhibition will be on display at the Art Gallery of Regina from April 9 to May 3, 2008.
